

## Tipsy Nine Patch

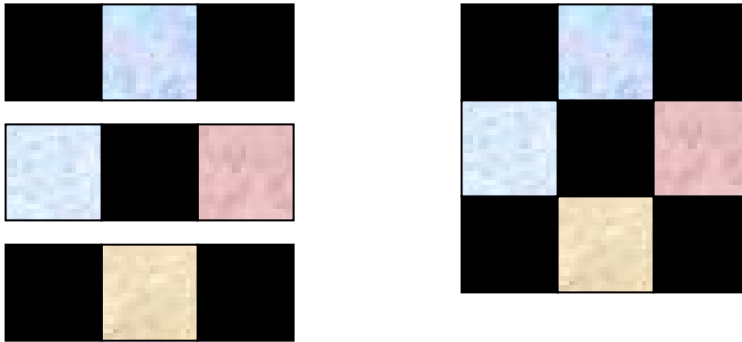
To make one block you will need the following fabrics:

5 - 2 ½” squares of black fabric

4 - 5 ½” squares of assorted batik fabrics - cut each square once diagonally to make 2 triangles.

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Select 5 black 2 ½” squares and 4 assorted 2 ½” squares. Arrange the squares as shown and sew rows together. This will make a nine patch unit. Press the seam allowances toward the black squares. Sew the top and bottom rows to the center row, matching seams. Press the seam allowances open.



Sew the matching half square triangles to the nine patch unit as shown to make a “square in a Square unit. Press away from the center. Trim the block to 9” x 9”.
